

Safety, Security, Health and Environmental Policy

South Hook LNG Terminal Company Ltd. (SHLNG) is committed to safeguarding human safety and health, conserving the environment, and ensuring the security of assets that are integral to its business. Meeting this commitment is central to the vision of SHLNG and requires continuous efforts to identify, eliminate or manage the risks to safety, health, the environment (SHE) and security associated with its activities. Accordingly, SHLNG will:

- Continue to develop, maintain and continually improve its Safety, security, Health & Environmental Management System (SHEMS)
- Ensure that SHE and security aspects are included in the design, construction, operation and maintenance of its facilities
- Comply with all laws, regulations and permits applicable to SHE and security, and apply responsible industry standards and prudent practices, where no relevant laws or regulations exist
- Set clear objectives, responsibilities and accountability for SHE and security performance across all levels within SHLNG, with measurement and reporting requirements set against stakeholder expectations and benchmarked against comparable organisations
- Respond quickly, effectively and with care to any emergency or accident that results from its operations, in co-operation with industry organisations and relevant Government or regulatory agencies
- Ensure that the appropriate training, supervision, information and resources are provided to SHLNG personnel to ensure that SHE and security objectives are achieved
- Establish methods for identifying, assessing and managing hazards and incidents through planning and exercising to ensure that risks are minimised to levels as low as reasonably practicable
- Ensure timely communication with all employees, contractors and the community on matters that may affect their safety, health, environment or security; with particular regard for actions that they need to take in the unlikely event of any incident
- Implement occupational health programmes designed to enhance the well-being, productivity, and personal safety of SHLNG personnel and contractors
- Ensure that energy and natural resources are used efficiently, pollution is prevented, and that waste and emissions are controlled and minimised
- Perform regular reviews to evaluate personnel commitment, measure progress and drive continuous improvement to ensure compliance with this policy
- Continue to develop a culture in which people understand their responsibilities in preventing all potential SHE and security incidents and providing a safe and healthy workplace
- Work with the industry, the Government and regulatory agencies and the public to contribute, where appropriate, to the development of effective laws and regulations based on sound evidence and the full consideration of associated risks, benefits and costs
- Only work with contractors that comply with all relevant laws and regulations, and all SHLNG policies, procedures and mandatory training requirements regarding SHE and security. SHLNG values contractors that demonstrate active injury and loss prevention programmes
- All levels of management, employees and contractors are expected to participate in and comply with all SHE and security initiatives, and to exercise individual responsibility for their own safety, the safety of others, and the protection of the environment
