

Visiting South Hook LNG Terminal



The South Hook LNG Terminal is located in Milford Haven, in the county of Pembrokeshire, West Wales, about 100 miles west of Cardiff. The South Hook LNG Terminal is a receiving and regasification facility. We are an Upper Tier COMAH (Control of Major Accident hazards) regulated site.

Safety at the Terminal is our top priority and we ask you to read the following important information in advance of your arrival.

Prior to your visit, please inform your host if any of the following circumstances apply to you:

- You are classified as a young person (under 18)
- You require any additional support, or have certain adjustments due to personal circumstances that need to be considered during your visit
- In the unlikely event of an emergency, you would need additional assistance or adjustments in an emergency evacuation

Identification

- Please bring photographic proof of your identity (preferably a Passport or Photo Card Driving Licence). If you do not have either of these documents please contact your South Hook LNG host, prior to your arrival at the Terminal
- If you will be working at South Hook LNG you will **also** need to bring with you proof of residence (e.g. utility bill). You will need this document, as well as one form of photographic identification, to allow you access to the Terminal

Vehicle Access

- Please adhere to the speed restrictions both on the approach road (25mph) and in the car park (10mph)
- Please ensure that you reverse park when parking your vehicle

Arrival

- On arrival, please report to the Security Gatehouse where you will receive a visitor's pass/access control swipe. This must be worn and be clearly visible at all times and returned to the Security Gatehouse before leaving the Terminal

Security

- All visitors and baggage will be subject to a search on arrival
- Our IT security systems will not allow visitors to link up laptops or use USB devices on our networks

- CCTV is in operation on site at all times
- Motorcycle helmets, snoods, scarves, balaclavas or any similar headwear that covers/partly covers the face should not be worn on site

Safety

- All visitors may be required to undertake Drug & Alcohol testing. Please bring evidence of any medication you are currently taking or have taken within the past week. Access to the Terminal may be denied if the Drug & Alcohol test results are positive
 - You will be required to watch a short introductory DVD, providing you with important safety information
 - Your South Hook LNG host will meet you at the Security Gatehouse on arrival or you will be escorted to them.
- Please stay with your host at all times**

- Smoking and Vaping is restricted to one designated area, where a fixed lighter is available
- Matches and lighters are not allowed on site
- Cameras are not allowed on site, unless authorised
- Objects that are considered weapons (guns, blades, sharp objects), will not be permitted on site, nor any objects considered to have the potential to be used with malicious intent
- Mobile phones and smart watches, fitness trackers or similar, are not allowed in the Process Area and Jetty Area. You should leave such items in your car, if possible, or they can be deposited at the Security Gatehouse and collected when leaving site
- Any electrical equipment must be declared to your South Hook LNG host

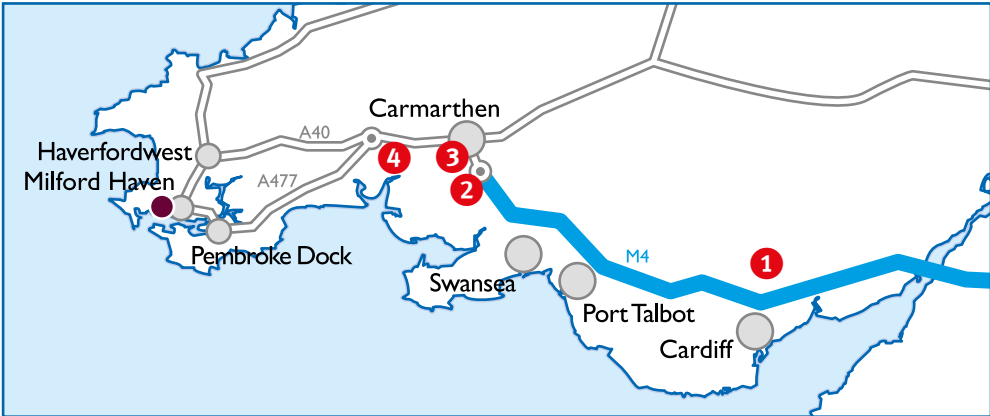

Directions to South Hook LNG Terminal

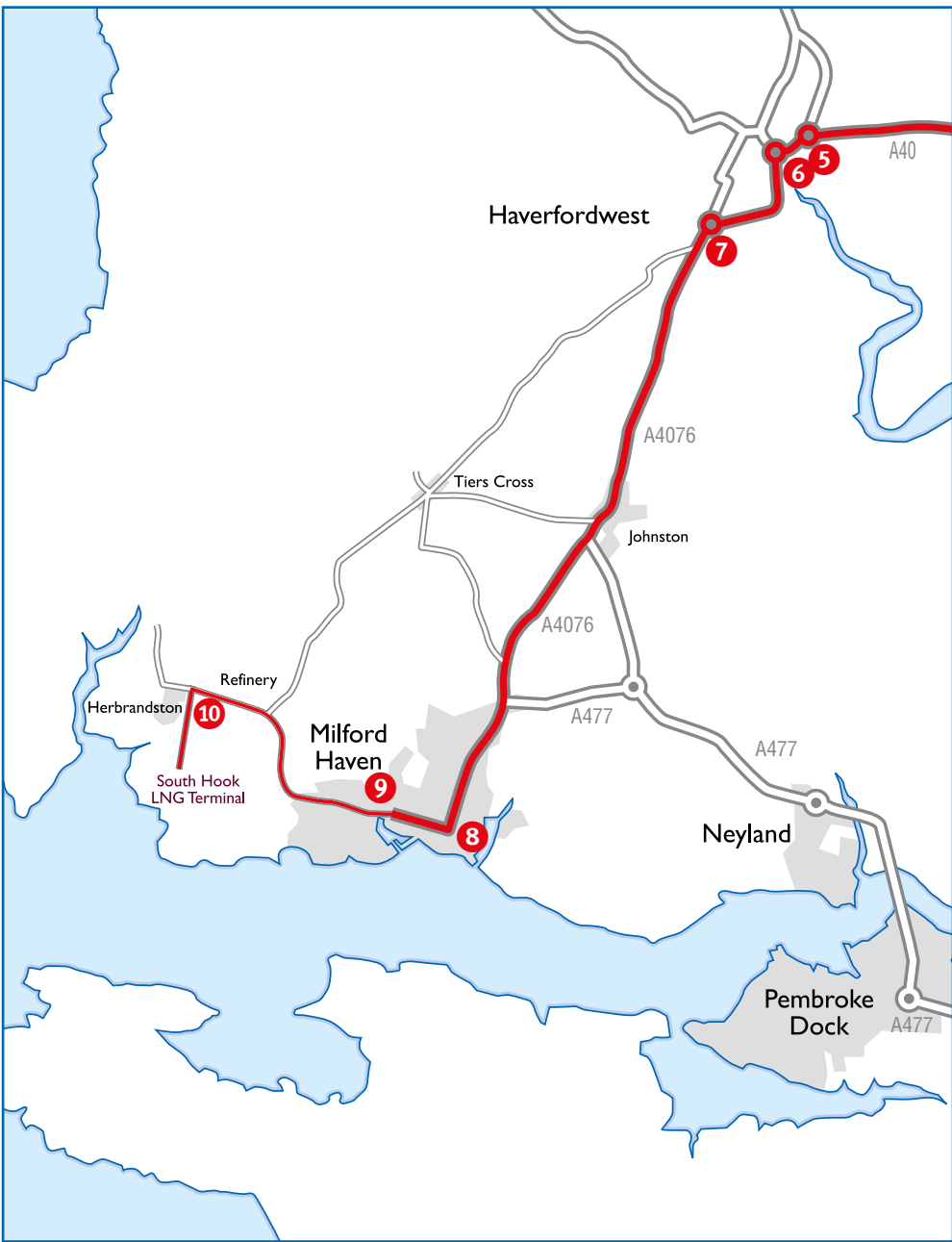


Directions: **by road** (via Haverfordwest)

- 1 M4 west from Cardiff
- 2 A48, **signposted Carmarthen**
- 3 A40, At roundabout take 2nd exit **signposted Fishguard, St Clears**
- 4 A40 At roundabout take 2nd exit **signposted Fishguard, Haverfordwest**
- 5 A4076 At roundabout take the 1st exit **signposted Milford Haven**
- 6 A4076 At next roundabout take 2nd exit **signposted Milford Haven**
- 7 A4076 At Merlin's Bridge traffic lights take 2nd exit **signposted Milford Haven** continue to follow A4076 to Milford Haven
- 8 Turn right onto **Hamilton Terrace**
- 9 At roundabout take 1st exit **signposted Hakin** cross bridge and bear right onto **St Lawrence Hill**
- 10 After 2 miles turn left into South Hook LNG Terminal. **2 white signs indicate our location.** (Red signs either side of the entrance indicate 'Private Road – No Access').

Directions: **by rail**

Trains from **London to Milford Haven**, calling at key stations: **Cardiff, Port Talbot and Carmarthen** en route.
